SPECIAL TELECONFERENCE NOTICE

Pursuant to Executive Order N-29-20:

The Brown Act, Government Code Section 54953, contains special requirements that apply when members of a legislative body participate in a public meeting by telephone. Certain of these requirements have been suspended by Paragraph 3 of Executive Order N-29-20, executed by the Governor of California on March 17, 2020, to mitigate the spread of Coronavirus (COVID-19). In particular, the Executive Order suspends that provision of the Brown Act that requires noticing, posting of agendas, and public access to each location where a member will be participating telephonically, as well as provisions that require physical presence of members of the legislative body or the public for purposes of a quorum or to hold a meeting. Executive Order N-29-20 allows an agency to conduct a teleconference meeting that provides members of the public telephonic or other electronic participation in place of making a physical location for the public to observe the meeting and provide public comment, consistent with other provisions of the Brown Act.

C. ADOPT RESOLUTION RECOMMENDING THE DRAFT FISCAL YEAR 2018/19 MEASURE L ANNUAL ACCOUNTABILITY REPORT FOR CITY COUNCIL APPROVAL

Deputy City Manager Keys provided a brief overview of administrative changes to the Draft Accountability Report presented to the Committee at its January 13, 2020 meeting. Changes included response to comments by the Committee Members on January 13.

Chair Pennino recommended a non-finance person to proof read the entire document, citing specific sections that were still difficult to understand.

Vice Chair Spring recommended adding specific language citing the date range for the 90-day report on the first page of the document.

Committee Member Hothi asked for clarification on the approval process of the final report and how it would be presented to City Council. Chair Pennino suggested and Committee Members concurred that the item should be presented on the consent calendar at the soonest Council meeting possible to respect the City Council's time and provide information to the public as soon as possible.

Measure L— FY 2018-2019

Annual Accountability Report In Brief

Citizens' Oversight Committee Members

Measure L, passed by voters in November 2018, is a local general purpose retail transactions and use tax that began April 1, 2019. This report covers the period from April 1, 2019 through June 30, 2019. City Ordinance No. 1953 requires preparation of an Annual Accountability Report to be reviewed by the Measure L Citizen's Oversight Committee and for the Committee to present findings to City Council. The Measure L ballot text was: *To make neighborhoods safer, maintain/improve essential City of Lodi services including: reducing crime; maintaining neighborhood police patrols/gang violence intervention/prevention; fixing potholes/city streets; maintaining neighborhood fire stations; enhancing rapid police/fire response times by restoring firefighter and adding police positions; maintaining recreation facilities/programs; and other general fund purposes; shall the city of Lodi measure enacting an ongoing half cent local sales tax, providing \$5,400,000 annually, with independent citizen oversight, and funds spent locally, be adopted?*




Measure L Highlights


- From April 1, 2019 through June 30, 2019, revenues received were \$1,453,364 compared to original estimates of \$1.2 million. Un-programmed revenues remain in the Measure L fund and will likely help reach the 3-year, 16% fund balance reserve target sooner than anticipated.
- In February 2019, City Council authorized \$980,720 in Measure L expenditures, including for: 6 new Peace Officers; 3 part-time Community Services Officers; 3 new Firefighters; 1 restored Battalion Chief; overtime to fully staff Engine 2031; 4 vehicle purchases; and all related equipment and training. Council subsequently approved unallocated 18/19 funds for police vehicles, and radio equipment for police and fire.
- The table (right) shows FY 2018/19 Measure L expenditures by category and encumbered funds. The table (below) shows expenditures by service type. Not including encumbrances, FY 18/19 Police expenditures were \$283,518 and Fire expenditures were \$366,702. Fire expenditures were primarily overtime labor to fully staff all engines. Police expenditures were primarily for new officers. Due to recruitment challenges, only the 6 full-time police officer positions were filled by June 30, 2019.
