

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON RESOLUTION OF INTENTION TO ANNEX TERRITORY
TO AN EXISTING COMMUNITY FACILITIES DISTRICT

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City Council of the City of Lodi on June 3, 2020, adopted its Resolution No. 2020-116, in which it declared its intention to annex territory to existing Community Facilities District No. 2007-1 (Public Services) (the "CFD"), and to levy a special tax to pay for certain public services, all pursuant to the provisions of the Mello Roos Community Facilities Act of 1982, Chapter 2.5, Part 1, Division 2, Title 5 of the California Government Code. The resolution describes the territory to be annexed, specifies the type of services to be financed, and describes the rate and method of apportionment of the proposed special tax. No change in the tax levied in the existing CFD is proposed. For further details, the resolution is available at the office of the City Clerk, City Hall, 221 W. Pine Street, Lodi, California.

NOTICE IS HEREBY FURTHER GIVEN that the City Council has fixed **July 15, 2020, at the hour of 7:00 p.m.**, or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard, at the regular meeting place of the City Council, Carnegie Forum, 305 W. Pine Street, Lodi, California, as the time and place when and where the City Council will hold a public hearing to consider the annexation. At the hearing, the testimony of all interested persons for or against the annexation of the territory or the levying of the special taxes will be heard.

Special Notice: While social distancing measures are imposed due to the COVID-19 pandemic, Council chambers will be closed to the public during meetings of the Lodi City Council. Alternatives, as set forth below, are available to members of the public to watch Council meetings and provide comments.
