

Again, as in the past, we are submitting our annual report for your information and review. This report reflects the activity of the Police Department during the past year.

In 1960 we continued to strive toward the goals set forth in 1958. The Juvenile Bureau was integrated with the Investigation Division for the purpose of supervision and to insure maximum benefit from available man-power. The results of this change have been very gratifying. We also continued to rotate officers in various temporary assignments such as parking meter enforcement, detective and identification bureaus. This policy has given the officers a chance to broaden their experience and has been of definite training value.


As for the future, we are naturally looking forward to new police facilities for which there is great need, especially in the detention of prisoners and classroom training quarters. There is also a need in at least three cases for reclassification of personnel, this however, will be taken up in detail at the 1961-1962 budget hearings.


ORGANIZATION CHART

# Law Enforcement Code of Ethics

**As a Law Enforcement Officer,** *my fundamental duty is to serve mankind; to safeguard lives and property; to protect the innocent against deception, the weak against oppression or intimidation, and the peaceful against violence or disorder; and to respect the Constitutional rights of all men to liberty, equality and justice.*

**I will** *keep my private life unsullied as an example to all; maintain courageous calm in the face of danger, scorn, or ridicule; develop self-restraint; and be constantly mindful of the welfare of others. Honest in thought and deed in both my personal and official life. I will be exemplary in obeying the laws of the land and the regulations of my department. Whatever I see or hear of a confidential nature or that is confided to me in my official capacity will be kept ever secret unless revelation is necessary in the performance of my duty.*

**I will** *never act officiously or permit personal feelings, prejudices, animosities or friendships to influence my decisions. With no compromise for crime and with relentless prosecution of criminals, I will enforce the law courteously and appropriately without fear or favor, malice or ill will, never employing unnecessary force or violence and never accepting gratuities.*

**I recognize** *the badge of my office as a symbol of public faith, and I accept it as a public trust to be held so long as I am true to the ethics of the police service. I will constantly strive to achieve these objectives and ideals, dedicating myself before God to my chosen profession . . . law enforcement.*
