

On the Cover

To continue the Parks, Recreation and Cultural Services 75th Anniversary, we selected another vintage photo to help commemorate the year-long celebration. Pictured on the cover is Lodi Lake taken from the west end. This picture was also featured in the January 2016 Activity Guide on the photo collage page.

Lodi Lake has always been a popular location for families to swim. In 1934 the City of Lodi purchased Lodi Lake. Over the years, Lodi Lake has been home to public swimming from the beach, hot rod boat races, and mud bike races. It wasn't until 1967 that it was proposed to expand the lake area to include fifty acres which is today the Nature Area. Today, this same area in the photo, includes a boat house offering kayak and paddle board rentals, a fence along Turner Road providing secure access to the beach area, a wading pool, parking and restroom facilities. During the hot summer months, Lodi Lake receives the greatest number of visitors and even greater numbers for the 4th of July fireworks from the lake, that has become a signature Lodi event.

Headwaters Kayak Treasure Hunt Winners!



The treasure hunt clues were not easy and took wit and creativity to solve the challenging clues created by the Parks, Recreation and Cultural Services Director, Jeff Hood.

The first of the two treasure hunts took place in early January and lasted four days. Each day a new clue was released on the Parks, Recreation & Cultural Services Department facebook and blog pages. These clues helped to identify the area of the city where the park was located, and clues detailing the location of the hidden medallion. The clues contained some local Lodi details as well as references from pop culture, so everyone had an equal shot at winning.



The first medallion was found by retired teacher Barry Clark. Mr. Clark found the medallion in the sedge grass under an oak limb near Pigs Lake in the Nature Area of Lodi Lake. He won a paddle board, life vest, and paddle all courtesy of the event sponsor Headwaters Kayak.

The second hunt took place in mid-January and offered a new set of clues and the same great opportunity to win a prize package worth over \$2000. Finding the medallion within an hour, local farmer Chris Machado, won the second Headwaters Kayak Treasure Hunt just after the first clue was posted. The medallion was under several inches of pine needles near a trunk of a River Sheoak tree at Roget Park.

We heard stories that families teamed up to solve the clues and search the parks. “We hope the participants enjoyed the search and gave them the opportunity to visit parks they may not have seen before” said event organizer, Michael Reese, Recreation Superintendent. The PRCS Department has enjoyed an excellent working relationship with Headwaters Kayak since it took over the operations of the boat house at Lodi Lake in 2014. We are glad to see more people using Lodi Lake for recreation, getting outdoors and getting active. Updates at Lodi Lake



Oak Tree Falls

This winter a massive oak tree toppled into Lodi Lake, pulling up about half the roadway in the process on the north side of the lake. The City's Public Works Department met with Parks Department staff to determine the necessary repairs to remove the tree and repair the roadway. The Parks, Recreation and Cultural Services Department is assessing other trees in the area for pruning and/or removal if they pose a potential hazard. Pictured is the 15 foot diameter root ball.

Boat Ramp Repairs

In early March, the construction contractor finished the below-waterline work on the new boat dock and ramp at Lodi Lake Park. Thanks, in part, to the Woodbridge Irrigation District, their cooperation to lower the dam a few days early, and delay raising it by a few more days, has allowed the project to be completed in a timely schedule. The boat ramp is anticipated to be open by May 2016.

A Lodi Lake annual 2016 Parking Pass can be purchased at the Recreation Office for \$50. Vehicle entrance and daily boat launch fee is \$13 and can be paid at the Lodi Lake entrance gate. For more information please call the Recreation office at (209) 333-6742.

Lodi Lake Nature Area Featured Docent Robert Rasmussen

LLNA Docent Since 2010



If you ever meet Lodi Lake Nature Area docent, Robert Rasmussen, on the nature trail, don't check his vest pockets. You could be very surprised. Mr. "R", or Mr. Rasmussen, as his students call him, is known to carry a small garter or king snake, black widow, swollen black tick, or alligator lizard in a cage in his vest pockets, to help his students get interested in the "creepy ugly" things found in nature. He uses these creatures as his "hook," or a way for his students to get interested in the outdoor world. Often he will also bring along a few trapped crayfish for the students to hold, if they are brave enough.

Robert has been a docent since 2010 when his very wise wife, Sharon, who has a background in child development, encouraged Robert to respond to a newspaper ad recruiting more docents. She thought this program would be a good fix for Robert's interests of salmon fishing, hiking and enjoying the outdoors. Robert joined the group and hasn't looked back. He enjoys being with kids while also helping his community appreciate nature.

Robert was raised in the Farmington area, met and married Sharon, then raised their family near Clements. They have two grown sons, one who is married and working as an attorney in Portland, Oregon and another who is a commercial appraiser in San Francisco about to be married in April. He and Sharon also live with 2, sometime 3, Golden Labrador Retrievers, which often can be found waiting patiently for him in the bed of his truck, parked near the Nature Area.

Who's That Guy? Winter Activity Guide Revisited

"This photo was obviously staged," says Jim, because the playground was all black top including the ball diamond. "There was no dirt or grass at that time" said Jim.

LODI LAKE NATURE AREA DOCENTS NATURE CARING COMMUNITY

DO YOU LOVE CHILDREN AND NATURE? Lodi is very fortunate to include a 110+ acre park along the Mokelumne River with a 58-acre nature area that is home to a community of plants and animals not found in most California urban areas. Please join the docents as a volunteer, usually no more than 2-3 tours a month, depending on season, or at one of their monthly meetings and learn more about this wonder-full place we call Lodi.

BUILDING A BETTER COMMUNITY- Lodi's docents help instill common community values with students and give a sense of empowerment to our youth through the Lodi Lake Nature Area Docent tours. Docents communicate to our young people that they are valued as fellow stewards of the environment and can also help serve as resources for the community through a lifestyle of community service, with the understanding that all citizens play a role in the care and conservation of our urban wild areas. "Ask not what Lodi can do you for you, but what you can do for Lodi!"

WHAT DOES IT TAKE? Once you have been interviewed, pass a fingerprint and background check, you will be issued a self-study Lodi Lake Docent's manual to study on your own time. Finish a take-home test, and then you are ready to start shadowing more experienced docents to learn the ways of a good tour. No science background necessary!

WHAT'S REQUIRED? Lead several tours a month or as much as you are available. Tours tend to cluster around the end of each school quarter, just before fall, winter, spring or summer breaks. Monthly docent meetings provide continuing education on the second Thursday of every month, held in the Lodi Police Department's Community Room, 215 W. Elm St., Lodi. Interesting speaker programs focus on range of topics related to nature and the river area. No cost to you for training, manual or docent uniform. ***Come help build a better community through its programs!***

FIELD STUDY TRIPS! TEACHERS and PARENTS! BOOK AN EDUCATIONAL TOUR THROUGH THE LODI LAKE NATURE AREA Grade level science standards are taught:

Kindergarten-Sixth Grade:







Parks, Recreation and Cultural Services hopes to eventually replace all the wooden poles in the park, located north of Harney Lane on Stockton Street.



Lesson Levels

Parent and Child (1-4 years)

Children work with their parent on basic skills, blowing bubbles, playing games, moving on their front and back, working towards independence from the parent to working with one of our instructors in a structured class.

Level 1-Minnow

This class helps students feel comfortable in the water and to enjoy the water safely. Students learn to submerge face independently and are introduced to floating and locomotion in a fun and safe environment.

Level 2-Seahorse

Successfully passing Level 1 or is able to fully submerge independently. Students learn kicking on front and back, basic breathing, front and back float, primary skills, 10 bobs and demonstration of alternating arms. This class gives students success with fundamental skills.

Level 3-Jelly Fish

Successfully passing Level 2 or able to swim and float independently on front and back. In this course, students will explore deep water, front crawl 15 yards; level off, introduction to breathing combined with a 5 yard stroke. This class builds on the skills in level 2 by providing additional guided practice.

Level 4-Otter

Successfully passing level 3 or is able to swim independently on front and back. Students will retrieve objects, swim 20 yards, coordinate the components of the front and back stroke, and tread water. This class develops confidence in the strokes learned and existing aquatic skills.

Level 5-Dolphin

This class provides further coordination and refinement of strokes. Students will demonstrate the survival float, deep water bobbing, refined breathing, standing dive, build endurance by swimming elementary backstroke, front and back crawl, basic breaststroke.

Level 6-Shark

This class refines the strokes so students swim with ease. Students will demonstrate breathing, diving skills, and will perform various strokes for increased distances.

Private lessons

We structure these classes to meet the individual needs of the participant.

Summer Swim League

This program is designed to introduce you to competitive swimming. You can refine your swimming stroke in a fun and enjoyable team setting. You must be a Swim Lesson Level 4 swimmer and be able to swim 25 yards without assistance. Practices are held each night, Monday-Thursday, with dual meets on Friday evenings. 

