BACKGROUND INFORMATION: The City Council approved the first Traffic Control Box Art Project in September 2012, using Art in Public Places funds for five signal boxes. The project was expanded in November 2013 when the Council approved funding for an additional 15 boxes. That project is ongoing.

Recreation Manager Jennifer Winn, the liaison to the Art Advisory Board, will brief the Council on the project to date. Members of the Board, who provide recommendations to the Council for expenditure of AiPP funds, will be available for questions and comments.

FISCAL IMPACT: Development impact fees support the Art in Public Places Fund.

FUNDING AVAILABLE: Not applicable.



HISTORY

- Art Advisory Board member saw painted traffic control boxes in other cities during 2012 travels, brought idea to board
- Board endorsed traffic box project for Lodi
- Council approved \$500 for five signal boxes in September 2012
 - Five at \$100 each
 - Paint/graffiti coat donated by Kelly-Moore
 - Funds from Art in Public Places (developer-paid) Fund
- Two artists submitted proposals, Phase I completed early 2013


