**RECOMMENDED ACTION:** Receive report on senior services in the City of Lodi.

**BACKGROUND INFORMATION:** The City of Lodi opened its senior center in 1990, constructing a portion of the Hutchins Street Square complex with a bequest from the estate of William Holz. The Center is open Monday through Friday from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m.

The LOEL Center, founded by William Holz, has provided services to seniors since the 1970s. It is unusual for a city the size of Lodi to have two senior centers operated by different organizations. Staff has been exploring ways to streamline, expand and improve the ways senior services are provided to the community. City staff, representatives of the LOEL Senior Center and Lodi Health will provide the Council with an oral report on these latest steps.
