BACKGROUND INFORMATION: Trains traveling through the City of Lodi on the Union Pacific Railroad (UPRR) mainline tracks are moving at speeds upward of 70 mph. Since 2009, there have been three train vs. pedestrian contacts, resulting in one injury and two fatalities.

The attached UPRR California Operation Lifesaver presentation is intended to increase public awareness of train safety. The information will be presented by a UPRR representative who will be available to answer any questions from the Council or public.
