RECOMMENDED ACTION: Tour and discussion regarding physical condition of Fire Station 2 and other City fire stations.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: This information is being presented to provide Council with an understanding of the current condition of City fire stations. The meeting is being held at Fire Station 2 to provide a visual presentation to Council of that building and the number of issues there.

The City of Lodi has four fire stations positioned throughout the City. Fire Station 1 is located at 210 W. Elm Street and was built in 1967. Fire Station 2 is located at 705 E. Lodi Avenue and was built in 1981. Fire Station 3 is located at 2141 S. Ham Lane and was built in 1974. Fire Station 4 is located at 180 N. Lower Sacramento Road and was completed in 2002. Fire Administration is located at 25 E. Pine Street.

Buildings utilized for public safety are supposed to be planned and built to withstand the effects of weather, time and continued use over a number of years. Fire stations are staffed 24 hours a day, 365 days a year and are subject to constant use and wear. Other significant damage may be attributed to the overall design and location of Fire Station 2. This station is not the oldest, but due to a number of design and construction shortcomings it has the largest number of concerns.
