Subject: Bank Robbery

Details: On today's date at approximately 12:43 PM, the Lodi Police Department received both a silent hold up alarm and a 911 phone call from F&M Bank at 1020 W. Kettleman Ln. Officers and Detectives responded to the bank. LPD learned the suspect entered the bank and demanded money be put into a plastic bag. The suspect implied he had an explosive device as well as a gun. The bank employees followed the suspect's demands and placed an undisclosed amount of cash in his bag. The suspect fled on foot running east through the parking lot and was last seen near the Arby's Restaurant.

The area was checked for the suspect and an explosive device, but neither were found.

The suspect was described as a white or Hispanic Male, approximately 5'8" tall, thin build, mustache. Suspect is in his late 40's or 50's years of age. He was wearing blue long sleeve painter coveralls, dark baseball hat and sunglasses. This case is under investigation and anyone with information is encourage to call or e-mail Detective Bradley.
