## *Burglary report*

### **Burglary Statistics for Sept. 20, 2009 through Oct. 21, 2009**

There were 68 burglaries in the City of Lodi during that time period. Of the 68 burglaries, 32 were vehicles, 27 were residential, 4 were businesses and 5 were other structures.

#### **Sunset District**

The Sunset District's geographical borders are generally east to Hutchins Street, north to city limits, west to the city limits, and south to city limits

#### **Heritage District**

The Heritage District's geographical borders are generally west to Hutchins Street, north to the city limits, east to the city limits and south to city limits but excluding the area of the Central District.

#### **Central District**

The Central District's geographical borders are generally west to Hutchins Street, north to Elm Street, south to Vine Street and East to Cherokee Lane.

***Additional Information:***

Analysis of the method of entry of 17 of the residential burglaries revealed that 5 were window smashes, 4 were knock and/or ring doorbell and 3 were pried windows or doors. The method of entry of 17 vehicle burglaries indicated that 14 were window smashes, 2 were punched locks and 1 was unknown.

All of the residential burglaries took place during the daytime along with some vehicle burglaries. All of the business burglaries and most of the vehicle burglaries occurred during the night time hours.
