Subject: Massage Parlor Manager Arrested

LPD Case #: 09-4172

Arrested: Khuu, Nga Thi 03/16/67 of Sacramento.

Details: On 05/21/09 at approximately noon, the manager of the Royal Day Spa 220 W. Lodi Avenue, Lodi was arrested for battery on a person, vandalism, and prostitution solicitation.

The incident occurred when a 32 year old male victim from Oregon went to the establishment to get a massage. The victim said he had received a gunshot wound in his back while serving in the United States Army in Iraq and often needs a "Shiatsu" style massage to help ease the pain. During the course of the massage, the masseuse/manager Nga Khuu offered to perform a sexual act for fifty dollars. The victim refused, but Khuu was persistent. Finally, the victim decided he was going to leave the establishment because Khuu was relentless. As the victim walked out Khuu demanded fifty dollars. When the victim refused, Khuu picked up a rock and threw it at the side of the victim's car causing a sizeable dent. Khuu then threw a rock at the victim, striking him in the chest. All the while, Khuu was yelling at the victim during the assault. The victim called the Lodi Police Department and demanded Khuu be arrested.

Lodi Police officers asked the victim if he needed medical attention, but he declined. The victim was visiting family in the area and was unfamiliar with the Royal Day Spa.

Khuu was charged with the aforementioned charges and an immigration hold was placed on Khuu.

The Lodi Police Department has received complaints regarding the Royal Day Spa. As a result of a recent investigation the business was placed on administrative suspension.
