

Dear Parks, Recreation & Cultural Services patrons,

The first half of 2013 has brought some amazing changes to public parks and facilities within the Parks, Recreation and Cultural Services' Department.

The focal point has been the Grape Bowl, which will be nearing the end of a major phase of renovations. The improvements include a new entry off Stockton Street, a new building that houses ticket sales, restrooms and concessions, a plaza overlooking the football field and handicap accessible ramps leading to the top of the south bleachers. Our challenge now is finding new types of events for the Grape Bowl that will attract people not only from the Lodi area, but surrounding regions.

We're also making progress on repairing the indoor pool at Hutchins Street Square and making it function better for users. The water is heated to between 84 and 88 degrees, making it perfect for exercise and therapy. We also will resume making it available for swimming parties on weekdays or other times by appointment.

Zupo Field has a new look with a sturdy outfield fence. Thanks to an incredible group of volunteers who raised money and then spent their free time demolishing the deteriorating right- and left-field fences, Zupo remains one of the region's premier parks for baseball.

Our Parks Division employees have invested significant time on preparing parks for spring and summer play, renovating baseball and softball fields. They provide a level of service not found in many other communities, so be sure to tell them how much you appreciate their hard work in our parks.

Lastly, the Recreation Division will be moving later this year to the former police station on West Elm Street. The space has been vacant since the Police Department moved to its new station, and the Public Works Department is overseeing renovations that will result in the Recreation Division (and Fire Department administrative offices) relocating in our civic hub. That will improve our ability to provide excellent customer service.

Enjoy spring, and take time to enjoy our parks.






Hutchins Street Square’s 100th Anniversary

The Hutchins Street Square Foundation held a small ceremony on February 13 to commemorate the 100th anniversary of the Square, formerly known as Lodi Union High School. The original cornerstone was placed on the same day a century ago. John Ledbetter, Chairman of the Foundation (pictured below), unveiled a plaque mounted on a wall near Kirst Hall to a crowd that included elected officials, Foundation members, City staff and former Lodi Union High School students.

The old high school site, at Hutchins Street between Walnut and Oak streets, served Lodi students from 1913 to 1977, when it was closed because of a fire. The buildings sat empty and decaying until the Old Lodi Union High School Site Foundation was formed and began fundraising and renovation. Between 1980 and 1998, the site was reborn as Lodi’s community center, Hutchins Street Square.

The Hutchins Street Square Foundation raises money to assist Hutchins Street Square continue its role as the premier event and conference center in the city. A special exhibit with the cornerstone’s time capsule contents from 100 years ago can be seen at the Weber-Kennedy Gallery of the Erickson Building at the San Joaquin County Historical Museum located in Micke Grove Park south of Lodi. The museum is open Wednesdays through Sundays, from 11 a.m. to 4 p.m.

Looking for something to do this summer? Children and families can stop by Hutchins Street Square West Park for the free Take it to the Park program. Children will be treated to arts and crafts and outdoor park games. This summer Take it to the Park will be offered on Saturdays in the month of June.

Parks, Recreation and Cultural Services Recreation Aids will lead activities in the mornings from 9 a.m. to noon before the heat of the summer day sets in. In the past, children have taken home creations made from corks, pipe cleaners, cotton balls, popsicle sticks, made drawings or just enjoyed old fashioned picnic group games.

This unique program is sponsored by the City of Lodi, and has received generous support from the community. The free program is in its fourth year and last summer it serviced more than 3,000 children and received \$200 in cash donations and several boxes of art supplies.

Take it to the Park is a drop-in program and adults are encouraged to accompany children. Families are welcome to participate in the activities and stay as long they wish. Community Contributors Needed! Help Make Swimming Pools Free during the Summer.

In a January Parks, Recreation and Cultural Services Department blog post, Department Director Jeff Hood, asked for the community help to make Lodi's pools free this summer. As a result, several local business, community groups, and individuals have agreed to sponsor Free Swim Weekends at Blakely Pool.

Last summer, during a particular hot spell in August, the City's Parks, Recreation and Cultural Services Department tried something different. The expanded hours of operation on Saturday and Sunday and opened on Friday, which is typically a day the pools are closed, and the admission was free. As a result, there were approximately 450 visitors in the three days. This demonstrated an big interest in visiting the pool, but even at \$1.50 admission that is too much for many of our residents.

Blakely Pool is just a short bike ride for many of the low-income children in the community, many of whom live in east Lodi within a walk or short bike ride to Blakely Park. This is just one of the two pools that are, unfortunately, little used by the general public. Our admission to the pool is \$1.50, a fairly insignificant figure to many of us. But our experience indicates even that appears to be a barrier for many to enjoy this public complex.

While the City cannot afford to operate the pools for free, we are reaching out to the community, hoping that some of our business friends, civic or community groups would consider sponsoring a weekend, a month or a summer of free swimming for children at Blakely and Enze Pool this summer. The expense would cover lifeguard staff costs for \$650 a weekend. At the date this

Activity Guide went to press many local businesses and civic organization have stepped up and have sponsored many of the weekends.

Many cities around us have closed their public pools because of the expense. Pools are very costly to operate. We are hopeful that with the community's help, we can offer even more opportunities to our youth to enjoy our pools. Lodi Arts Foundation – Making a Difference

Lodi Arts Foundation initiated efforts last year to increase the awareness of the Art Tuition Assistance Program for underserved youth. As a result of the Foundation's outreach several new students have successfully applied for class tuition assistance. The program provides a 50-percent discount of class tuition towards one class per month, per student, for a one-year period for low-income families. Children have the opportunity to participate in art, music, and dance classes, which are held at Hutchins Street Square.

The Lodi Arts Foundation was established in 1998 as a non-profit organization to assist in creating a vibrant and diverse arts culture in the community. The Foundation raises funds to advance the arts in Lodi. The group raises funds through various events such as the Artisan Masters Wine & Art Auction, which was a collaboration with local wineries, artists and chefs, and on an ongoing basis tending bar (known as "The Pub") for various events held at Hutchins Street Square. Foundation members also provide support for First Friday Art Hops, the Arts Open House, and in various other ways.

Foundation chairperson, Ros Bollinger, said the group is developing plans for more activities to raise funds to support the arts in Lodi. "We are considering a series of music events and currently working on a new web site to take better advantage of using social media in our fundraising efforts," she said. Currently, the Foundation is seeking three to five new members. Professionals willing to share their expertise in areas such as fundraising, marketing, web site development, community relations, and finance are especially needed.

Drive by and see the progress – Grape Bowl Improvements

In December 2012, work began on the next phase of the Grape Bowl Improvement Project. When completed the project will provide a new entrance on Stockton Street, a retaining wall, a new building for concession, tickets, and restrooms will be directly behind the scoreboard. There will also be a new ramp for visitors on the south side of the stadium to the bleachers.

By early February, the project was starting to take shape and construction crews have been making good progress. About 645 cubic yards of dirt was delivered to the stadium, which helped the earth-moving equipment and compactors make good progress creating a ramp that will take spectators from the future Stockton Street entrance to the south bleachers.

The estimated completion date of the project is late Spring 2013.

Art

Introduction to Art Clay Silver

In this workshop the student will learn all about Art Silver Clay and how it can be used to create beautiful jewelry in hours rather than days. No jewelry making experience is necessary. Each workshop will feature different projects. Art Silver Clay is exactly as the name describes. It is clay that is 99.9% fine silver with the addition of a nontoxic binder and water. Because it is clay, it can be molded, rolled, shaped, carved, stamped, draped and adorned with other elements to create beautiful jewelry. Once the clay is formed, it is fired in a kiln or with a butane torch. The binder and water burn away and the student is left with a beautiful piece of fine silver jewelry. The instructor will discuss the Art Clay medium; demonstrate techniques and help students create two pieces of jewelry. All necessary tools are provided. Each student will walk away from class with two finished pieces of jewelry. The supply fee is payable to instructor at the class meeting and includes art clay silver and all necessary tools.




