Caltrans and Regional Transportation Agencies to hold a Community Workshop for the State Route 12 Corridor Study

The State Route 12 communities in Solano, San Joaquin and Sacramento counties are invited to participate in a public meeting on Tuesday, July 26, 2011 from 6 p.m. to 8 p.m. at the Lodi Public Library, Community Room, 201 Locust St., Lodi, CA 95240.

The meeting is part of an ongoing collaboration between Caltrans, the Solano Transportation Authority (STA), San Joaquin Council of Governments (SJCOG), Metropolitan Transportation Commission (MTC), and Sacramento Council of Governments (SACOG) to improve safety and operations along the SR 12 Corridor.

Participants in the meeting will review future traffic conditions along the corridor and discuss potential improvement strategies. This busy stretch of highway is 52 miles long connecting State Route 29 and Interstate 5.

The goal of the study is to develop a multi-jurisdictional corridor management plan that includes public input on a set of near-and long-term improvement strategies for SR-12. This plan will build upon and update existing studies for the SR-12 corridor.
