Additional Spray Areas Scheduled for Mosquito Control

(STOCKTON, CA) – In response to significant West Nile virus activity and adult mosquito populations in San Joaquin County and the associated risk to humans, the San Joaquin County Mosquito & Vector Control District (District) is preparing to conduct additional adult mosquito control operations using aerial and ground units. Additional areas include: an expanded area of rural Escalon; east Ripon area; portion of the City of Tracy, and a portion of the City of Lodi.

Year to date there are 52 dead birds and 83 mosquito samples testing WNV positive in San Joaquin County.

Due to adult mosquito populations and West Nile virus activity, the following areas are scheduled for spraying:

Aerial spraying for adult mosquito control using Evergreen 60-6, is scheduled for the evening of Wednesday, August 6, 2008, 8:00 pm to Thursday, August 7, 2008, 6:00 am.

>**North** to Eight Mile Rd., >**South** to Charter Way / Martin Luther King Blvd. / Hwy 4 >**West** to 3 miles west of I-5, >**East** to West Ln / Airport Way

Aerial spraying for adult mosquito control using Evergreen 60-6, is scheduled for the evening of Thursday, August 7, 2008, 8:00 pm to Friday August 8, 2008, 6:00 am.

Ground spraying for adult mosquito control using Pyrenone 25-5, is scheduled for the evening of, Thursday, August 7, 2008 between the hours of 7:30 pm to 11:00 pm.

>**North** to River Road, >**South** to Stanislaus County Line, >**West** to Sexton Rd., >**East** to Murphy Rd.

Ground spraying for adult mosquito control using Pyrenone 25-5, is scheduled for the morning of, Friday, August 8, 2008 between the hours of 4:00 am to 6:30 am.

Ground spraying for adult mosquito control using Pyrenone 25-5, is scheduled for the morning of, Friday, August 8, 2008 between the hours of 4:00 am to 6:30 am.

>**North** to Lodi Ave., >**South** to Morse Rd., >**West** to Hutchins St./ West Ln, >**East** to Highway 99.

Additional Spray Areas Scheduled for Mosquito Control - continued

The District will continue to implement the California Mosquito-Borne Disease Surveillance and Response Plan to protect the public health and welfare. Spray locations and times will normally be available 24 hours in advance. **People can access spray information and spray schedules by calling the District at (209) 982-4675 or toll-free at 1-800-300-4675 during business hours from 7:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. and 12:30 p.m. to 3:30 p.m., Monday through Friday or by visiting the District's website online at www.sjmosquito.org.**

Spraying for adult mosquitoes is done near sunset or sunrise with trucks and airplanes when mosquitoes are most active. The District will be using sprayers that apply a very fine mist of material that kills adult mosquitoes on contact. Control operations are contingent upon favorable weather conditions and if canceled, will typically be rescheduled to the following day.
