- **Coats and Cans at the Curb - 15th Annual**

During the Clean Up week, each resident may place the equivalent of up to six 32-gallon trash carts at the curb on their scheduled collection day. All items must be bagged, bundled, boxed or containerized and must weigh less than 50 pounds each. Due to Safety and Environmental Regulations No hazardous material, toxic waste, televisions, computers or other electronic items, tires, dirt, sod, rock or concrete are allowed for this clean up. - **Electronic and Universal Waste Free Drop-off Events**
February 14, 2009 - May 9, 2009 - August 8, 2009 - November 14, 2009

Events will take place at the Lodi Transfer Station, 1333 E Turner Road, Lodi. The following items which are no longer allowed in the trash will be accepted at this free collection event: Televisions, Computer Monitors, Laptops, Computer, Processing Units, Printers, Fluorescent Lamps, Mercury Thermometers, and Batteries (no car batteries).
