1. Paperbark Maple, *Acer griseum*, reddish bark peels away
deciduous, excellent fall color, good in turf, slow to 25 ft. tall X 25 ft. wide
2. Japanese Maple, *Acer palmatum*, sun or shade tolerant
deciduous, excellent fall color, good in turf, slow to 20 ft. tall X 20 ft. wide
3. Crimson Sentry Maple, *Acer platanoides* 'Crimson Sentry', purple foliage
deciduous, excellent fall color, good in turf, slow to 25 ft. tall X 15 ft. wide
4. Crimson King Maple, *Acer platanoides* 'Crimson King', purple foliage
deciduous, excellent fall color, good in turf, slow to 25 ft. tall X 25 ft. wide
5. Compact Strawberry Tree, *Arbutus unedo* 'Compacta', strawberry-like fruit, DT
evergreen, white flw. in spring, slow to moderate to 6-15 ft. high X 6-15 ft. wide
6. Western Redbud, *Cercis occidentalis*, magenta flw. in spring, CA native, DT
deciduous, excellent fall color, slow to moderate to 10-18 ft. tall X 10-18 ft. wide
7. Pink Dawn Chitalpa, *Chitalpa tashkentensis* 'Pink Dawn', DT
deciduous, lavender-pink flw. in spring to fall, fast to 20-30 ft. tall X 20-30 ft. wide

8. Flowering Dogwood, *Cornus florida*, flw. vary by variety
deciduous, abundant spring flws., slow to moderate to 20 ft. tall X 20 ft. wide
9. Silverberry, *Elaeagnus pungens*, oval ½ in. red fruit with silver dust
evergreen, grayish green leaves, moderate to fast to 6-15 ft. high X 6-15 ft. wide
10. Red Escallonia, *Escallonia rubra*, glossy dark green leaves, DT
evergreen, red flw. in spring & summer, fast to 6-15 ft. high X 6-15 ft. wide
11. Pineapple Guava, *Feijoa sellowiana*, fruit and red and white flowers are edible, DT
evergreen, gray-green leaves, moderate to fast to 18-25 ft. tall X 18-25 ft. wide
12. Hollywood Juniper, *Juniperus chinensis 'Torulosa'*, irregular, twisted branches
evergreen, rich green color, slow to moderate to 15 ft. tall X 15 ft. wide
13. Tolleson's Blue Weeping Juniper, *Juniperus 'Tolleson's Blue Weeping'*
evergreen, blue-green thread like branches, slow to moderate to 20 ft. tall X 20 ft. wide
14. Cypress-leaf Juniper, *Juniperus virginiana 'Cupressifolia'*
evergreen, dark green compact pyramid, slow to moderate to 15-20 ft. tall
15. Skyrocket Juniper, *Juniperus virginiana 'Skyrocket'*
evergreen, blue gray compact pyramid, slow to moderate to 10-15 ft. tall

16. Golden Rain Tree, *Koelreuteria paniculata* *, DT
deciduous, yellow flw. in summer, slow to moderate to 20-35 ft. tall X 10-40 ft. wide
17. Crape Myrtle, *Lagerstromia indica* *, different colored flowers by variety, DT
deciduous, excellent fall color, flw. in summer, slow to 30 ft. tall X 30 ft. wide
18. Crabapple, *Malus 'Prairifire'*, reddish-pink flw. in spring, red-purple fruit
deciduous, excellent fall color, moderate to 20 ft. tall X 15 ft. wide
19. St. Mary Magnolia, *Magnolia grandifolia* 'St. Mary' *
evergreen , white flw. in summer & fall, moderate to 20 ft. tall X 20 ft. wide
20. Saucer Magnolia, *Magnolia soulangiana*
deciduous, white flw. in spring before leaves, moderate to 25 ft. tall X 25 ft. wide
21. Star Magnolia, *Magnolia stellata*
deciduous, white flw. in spring before leaves, moderate to 10 ft. tall X 20 ft. wide
22. Fraser's Photinia, *Photinia fraseri*, new growth bright bronzy red, DT
evergreen, white flw. in spring, fast to 10-15 ft. high X 10-15 ft. wide
23. Japanese Black Pine, *Pinus thunbergiana* *
evergreen, very hardy, excellent garden tolerance, slow to moderate to 30 ft. tall
24. Pink Flowering Plum, *Prunus blireiana*, little or no fruit, purple leaves
deciduous, pinkish-rose double flw. in spring, moderate to 25 ft. tall X 20 ft. wide

25. Purple Leaf Plum, *Prunus cerasifera* 'Krauter Vesuvius', little or no fruit
deciduous, light pink flw. in spring, moderate to 18 ft. tall X 12 ft. wide

26. Hollyleaf Cherry, *Prunus illicifolia*, CA native, DT
evergreen, white flw. in spring, purple fruit, moderate to 20-30 ft. high X 20-30 ft. wide

27. English Laurel, *Prunus laurocerasus*
evergreen, white flw. in summer, fast to 20-30 ft. high X 20-30 ft. wide

28. Flowering Cherry, *Prunus yedoensis* 'Akebono'
deciduous, pink flw. in spring, moderate to 25 ft. tall X 25 ft. wide

29. Evergreen Pear, *Pyrus kawakami* *, semi-deciduous in cold winters
evergreen, white flw. in spring, moderate to fast to 20-30 ft. tall X 20-30 ft. wide

30. Prairie Gem Pear, *Pyrus ussuriensis* 'MorDak', very hardy, small fruit
deciduous, white flw. in spring, dark green leaves, moderate to 25 ft. tall X 25 ft. wide

31. Italian Buckthorn, *Rhamnus alaternus*, bright shiny green foliage
evergreen, greenish-yellow flw. in spring, fast to 12-20 ft. tall X 12-20 ft. wide

32. African Sumac, *Rhus lancea*, irregular branching habit, DT
evergreen, willow-like dark green leaves, slow to 25 ft. tall X 25 ft. wide

Edible fruit bearing trees such as apples, pears, cherries, plums, peaches, nectarines, and citrus, providing they are grown on a semi-dwarf rootstock which limits the height to 12-20 ft.

* Also used as a street tree for the City of Lodi.

DT = drought tolerant once established
