

**LODI CITY COUNCIL
SPECIAL CITY COUNCIL MEETING
CARNEGIE FORUM, 305 WEST PINE STREET
TUESDAY, APRIL 13, 2021**

A. Call to Order / Roll Call

The Special City Council meeting of April 13, 2021, was called to order by Mayor Nakanishi at 7:00 a.m.

- B-1 Adopt Resolution Reaffirming the Ratification of the City Manager's Proclamation Finding the Continued Existence of a Local Emergency and Rendering Certain Emergency Orders, Including an Increase Related to the Local Emergency in the City Manager's Contracting Authority for Services and Goods to a Maximum Amount of \$250,000 for the Duration of the Local Emergency (CA)

City Attorney Magdich provided a presentation regarding the continued existence of a local emergency.

City Attorney Magdich explained that reaffirming the existence of a local emergency every thirty days was the direction staff had been given by Council at the onset of the pandemic and that staff also reports the pandemic-related costs to the Council monthly, in response to a question asked by Council Member Hothi.

Mayor Nakanishi noted that this has come before the Council many times and the Council is familiar with the resolution.

Mayor Pro Tempore Chandler made a motion, second by Mayor Nakanishi, to adopt Resolution No. 2021-93 reaffirming the ratification of the City Manager's proclamation finding the continued existence of a local emergency and rendering certain emergency orders, including an increase related to the local emergency in the City Manager's contracting authority for services and goods to a maximum amount of \$250,000 for the duration of the local emergency.
