

# Lodi Electric Utility Electric Vehicle Charger and Installation Rebate

Get up to a \$6,000 Lodi Electric Utility (LEU) rebate on the purchase and/or installation of a new electric vehicle (EV) charger and dedicated EV meter in order to take advantage of LEU's EV charging rate.

## Rebate Amount

Residential: Install a new level 2 electric vehicle charger and receive a rebate up to \$1,000. Each LEU residence may qualify for:

- Up to \$500 for the purchase of a level 2 charger
- Up to \$500 to cover the costs of permitting, installation and electrical work needed to install a dedicated EV charging meter

Commercial: Install a new level 2 electric vehicle charger and receive a rebate up to \$6,000. Each LEU commercial account may qualify for:

- Up to \$3,000 for the purchase of a level 2 charger
- Up to \$3,000 to cover the costs of permitting, installation and electrical work needed to install a dedicated EV charging meter

## How to Apply

- Buy and install a new level 2 electric vehicle charger (charging station)
- Complete and submit the Level 2 Electric Vehicle Rebate Application along with the following required documentation:
  - receipt or paid invoice from the charger purchase, installation and permitting fees
  - receipt or paid electrician's invoice showing the itemized and subtotaled cost of the charger installation and/or electrical upgrade (invoice must include the electrician's license number)
  - final, signed building permit

## Eligibility

- Application must be fully completed
- The rebate is available only to LEU residential and commercial customers current on their utility charges
- Limit one rebate per charger and one rebate per installed meter per residence or per commercial account
- A charger with multiple ports, or plugs, is considered one unit and is eligible for a single rebate
- Receipts and invoices must be dated within 6 months of application
- Qualifying level 2 (240-volt) charging stations:
  - must be new, and not used, resold or rebuilt
  - must be wall or pedestal-mounted, and not portable
  - must be certified by Underwriters Laboratories Inc. (UL Listed); or ETL Listed
  - must not be received from warranty insurance claims
- Charger installation work must be performed by an electrician with a valid C-10 license.
- Eligible electrical upgrades:
  - must be permitted
  - must be performed by an electrician with a valid C-10 license
  - may include a new 240-volt outlet, a new 240-volt circuit, and/or a new or upgraded panel

## **Permitting**

- Installing a level 2 charger requires a permit from the City of Lodi. Building permit applications may be submitted in person at City Hall at 221 W Pine Street, Lodi 95241.

## **Terms & Conditions**

- This rebate is subject to availability of funds and is offered on a first come first served basis.
- Rebate will not exceed 100 percent of the actual cost of the charger and the installation as shown on the vendor invoice less sales tax.
- The level 2 charger must be installed at customer's service address.
- Customer is solely responsible for installation of the level 2 charger to the manufacturer's specifications.
- Customer agrees that LEU reserves the right to inspect the installation premises of the level 2 charger for 24 months after the date of application or request additional documentation prior to rebate payment. Rebate may be revoked by LEU if this condition is not met by the customer.
- Customer agrees that all credits allowed by the State of California's low carbon fuel standard credits program are the property of and belong to LEU. Customer agrees not to take any actions to generate such credits to its account. Customer further agrees to assign any such credits to LEU.
- Lodi Electric Utility and the City of Lodi disclaim any and all liability, loss, or damage that may arise as a result of the applicant's participation in this program.
