How Does the EP Meter Work?



1: Lodi Electric installs a special meter on your home that keeps track of delivered energy and received energy in real time.

2: Delivered energy is any energy delivered to our customer from the Lodi Electric grid.

3: Received energy is any energy received from our customer to the Lodi Electric grid.



4: When your solar system is generating sufficient power to cover the energy needs in the home there is no energy usage charge or credit. Your system is covering your energy needs.



5: What happens when your solar system is not generating enough energy to meet your homes energy needs? The Lodi Electric power grid will deliver enough power to meet your needs.



6: If I am away from my home and nothing is on, what happens to the energy my solar system is generating? Any excess solar energy is sent to and received by the Lodi Electric grid.



7: Your monthly bill will reflect delivered energy that will be billed per kWh at the retail rate. It will also reflect received energy as a credit per kWh at the avoided cost or wholesale rate.
