What is the Brian M. Stocker Fund?

Brian M. Stocker, who died in 2010 at the age of 48, eight years after a life-altering automobile accident, passionately believed in youth athletics as a catalyst for instilling leadership skills, personal responsibility, teamwork, fair play and healthy living. Compelled to establish a legacy to fulfill his goals, Brian left the bulk of his significant estate for the express purpose of establishing a permanent charitable fund to support local organizations and initiatives aligned with his interests.

Brian's passion for aquatic sports began at a young age as a member of the now defunct Morada Mini-Subs, part of the Lodi Summer Swim Program. He later served as a summer lifeguard and swam competitively for Tokay High School. Later, Brian excelled in ocean kayaking and sailing, coached youth swimming, competed in triathlons and swam with the local Master's program.

Lodi's aquatics programs are eligible to receive as much as \$275,000 in grant funding to boost participation over the next 10 years, especially among economically disadvantaged youth, through a partnership with the Brian M. Stocker Fund at The Community Foundation of San Joaquin.

Who can apply?

- Families and individuals residing in Lodi or whose children attend Lodi Unified School District and meet the age and income eligibility requirements (based on the Lodi Utility SHARE program).
 - Age requirements for each program:
 - Lifeguard Training: 15-18 years old
 - Summer Swim League: 5-18 years old
 - Swim Lessons: 6 months-10 years old

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How do I apply?

- Applications will be processed within two business days.
- If approved, applicants will receive an email receipt of enrollment for the registered class.
- If denied, applicants will receive an email and phone call from department staff.
