



Do You Know Where Your Electricity Comes From?

As required by law, each year the **Lodi Electric Utility** prepares and submits its **Power Content Label** - an annual report that shows where your electricity was generated during the calendar year and how it compares to the State of California's power mix.

More than 35 percent of Lodi's electric supply mix for 2021 was sourced from carbon-free resources.
