NOTICE OF FUNDING AVAILABILITY (NOFA) FOR THE 2023-24 PROGRAM YEAR**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on **Thursday, December 15, 2022**, the City of Lodi's Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program will release **funding applications** for the 2023-24 program year.

The City anticipates receiving approximately \$600,000 in CDBG funds for the 2023-24 CDBG program year. Approximately, \$130,000 will be available to community-based organizations for capital improvement and non-public service projects. Eligible types of activities include public services, public facility and infrastructure improvements, park improvements, affordable housing projects, economic development programs and more, see application instructions. Successful CDBG applications will address significant needs within the City and must meet the qualifications outlined in the application guidelines. If selected, funding will be available July 1, 2023. **Applications will be released on December 15, 2022 and must be submitted by Friday, January 27, 2023 at 5:00pm.**
