Truck Parking Allowable Parking Locations

PUBLIC PROPERTY

The City of Lodi regulates truck parking on public streets under Lodi Municipal Code Section 10.52.050. Per this section, trucks exceeding a maximum gross vehicle weight rating of 10,000 pounds can park only along signed portions of the streets shown on this map. Parking in some areas is allowed only between the hours of 7 pm and 7 am, with all day parking allowed in other areas. Truck parking along all other streets is prohibited unless the vehicle is in the process of being loaded or unloaded.



PRIVATE PROPERTY

The City of Lodi also regulates truck parking on private property in residential zones under Lodi Municipal Code Section 17.32.030D. This section prohibits the parking of vehicles which are strictly commercial in nature and have a gross load capacity greater than one and one-half tons. The types of vehicles include, but are not limited to, tow trucks, ambulances, mini-buses, large delivery and/or service trucks. Vehicles placed out of public view and located behind the designated front setback line or for immediate loading or unloading goods or people are exempt from this restriction.
